The Dante Alighieri Society of Pueblo is pleased to award several \$1000 scholarships to area high school seniors who have completed two or more years of Italian. Eligible students must have a 3.5 GPA in Italian and a 3.0 GPA overall.

Scholarship application instructions:

1. Complete the attached application.
2. Provide two letters of recommendation including a letter from your Italian teacher.
3. Submit an official high school transcript.
4. If selected, you will be required to attend the scholarship awards luncheon at the **Pueblo Country Club on Sunday, May 5, 2019, at 12:00 PM.** Winners should be prepared to say a few words in Italian thanking the organization for the scholarship.

In order to receive the \$1000 for the Dante Alighieri Scholarship students must:

1. Successfully complete (grade of C or better) one year (2 semesters or 3 trimesters) of Italian at an accredited university. The Italian courses must be completed following high school graduation.
Concurrent enrollment courses do not fulfill this requirement.
2. Submit an unofficial transcript, a copy of the scholarship certificate, and the Dante Alighieri Scholarship reimbursement form.
3. Complete the Italian courses within four academic years.

Scholarship Deadline: March 27, 2019

Applicants should give this completed application form, an official transcript, and two letters of recommendation to the Italian teacher at their high school.
